

RM SafetyNet - Important upgrade due

You will very likely have seen an email or letter regarding some changes that we need to make to our SSL interception certificates.

Why?

At the start of 2015, we introduced 'SSL interception' functionality to RM SafetyNet. This gave us the ability to successfully intercept and filter inappropriate search results, following Google's decision to implement HTTP encryption for Google searches. Since then, Google and other major web and cloud service providers have announced plans to stop allowing access to sites using security certificates signed using the older SHA-1 hash algorithm.

What will be changing?

In order to future-proof RM SafetyNet and support future changes to browser security requirements, RM is issuing a new trusted root certificate which uses a stronger SHA-384 hash algorithm. This stronger algorithm will reduce the need to issue further root certificate updates in the future.

A new certificate to all computers and devices that browse via an RM SafetyNet filtered connection by the **28th February 2017.**
